

# Alcohol 96% TSDA-1 Denatured

Neutral and colourless. Extra neutral alcohol 96% is denatured according to TSDA-1 to clients in Europe. Used in disinfectants, cosmetics, skincare products, and other beauty items.



Neutral and colourless. Mainly used in industrial applications such as solvents, cleaning products, vehicle windscreen wash, and burning alcohol.

## **Non-Food-Grade Ethanol**

<u>ABV at 20°C > 60% isoamyl alcohol</u>

## CO Fusel Oil

Pungent odour and colour ranging from pale yellow to dark green. Used as a high boiling point solvent, for example, in the lacquer industry. It also serves as a fragrance enhancer in the cosmetics industry.

## **()** Isoamyl Alcohol

Its pleasant, fruity smell makes it a popular ingredient in the manufacture of perfumes, cosmetics, fuel, and flavourings, especially banana oil.

## **Raw Materials**

All of our raw materials have at least 96% alcohol by volume at 20°C, are neutral in odour, and colourless. Read more to discover the applications of each product:

#### **Sugar Cane Alcohol**

Used in applications such as distilled spirits, preservatives, and solvents for colourants and flavours.





#### **Sugar Beet Alcohol**

Used in applications such as distilled spirits, vinegar, and solvents for colourants and flavours.

#### **Potato Alcohol**

Used in the production of vodka and other spirits, as well as in non-food applications within the pharmaceutical and cosmetics industries.



#### **Grain Alcohol**

Made from raw materials such as wheat, corn, rye, barley, and rice. It is used as a flavouring agent in cooking and baking, as well as for imparting traditional flavours to spirits such as whisky and brandy.





#### **Grape Alcohol**

It is used in a range of traditional drinks, including sherry and other fortified wines, pomace brandies such as grappa, and spirits such as gin and vodka.

#### **Apple Alcohol**

Crafted from the fermentation of apples, it is a key ingredient in traditional alcoholic beverages. In the non-food industry, it is used in cleaning solutions, solvents, and disinfectants.
